

Constructing your protest sign

Following this page are six pages that make up the protest sign. Each page is a tile of the bigger sign. Trim the right and bottom edges of each printed page, then line up the parts. There is a little overlap between each tile, so your trimming does not need to be perfect. The two right-most pages have crop marks that you can use to cut off the excess.
